

FLEET

Smaller, more intimately sized ships are large enough to be spacious and comfortable, yet small enough to visit unique destinations that larger ships cannot reach. Combined with experienced, friendly crews they create an intimate, welcoming atmosphere, and an altogether distinctively British experience.





Balmoral – originally the *Crown Odyssey* (and later *Norwegian Crown*), the *Balmoral* has been lengthened, renewed and refreshed and is the largest ship at 1,300 passengers. She has a large spa, on deck jacuzzis, two freshwater swimming pools and golf facilities.





Black Watch – originally built for Royal Viking Line, she is just over 28,000 tonnes and holds 750 happy passengers. The ship's public areas were refurbished in 2009, adding a new casual dining area – the Braemar Garden.





Boudicca – originally also built for Royal Viking Line and is a sister to the *Black Watch*. Holds 800 passengers. New engines and complete rebuild in January 2006. Big teak decks, lovely dining room, great public rooms. English theme throughout.





Braemar – originally the *Crown Dynasty*, this 900 passenger ship was lengthened and refurbished in the spring of 2008. *Braemar* has a classy five-deck atrium, great public rooms, a lovely dining room and a superb overall ambiance for your guests.
